DEVELOPMENT SERVICES - PLANNING - Director Walter Sullivan

A. ACTION TO APPROVE A 'DINING ROOM WITH BEER AND WINE' LIQUOR LICENSE FOR EVANGELINA VELASCO, DOING BUSINESS AS TAQUERIA LA GUADALUPANA, LOCATED AT 2495 NORTH CARSON STREET, CARSON CITY (8:35:20) - Evangelina Velasco - Member Furlong advised that the Sheriff's Office did not object to her having a Liquor License. The background check was complete. He also disclosed that she is a legal alien whose Green Card expires in June 2009. She must obtain another card or have the current card extended if she does not obtain citizenship before that date. Ms. Velasco indicated that she is aware of this condition and agreed to it. Discussion explained the location of the establishment and that she will be allowed to sell liquor for on premise use only. Outside sales will not be allowed. Chairperson Teixeira cautioned her against the sale of beer and wine to minors. He also reminded her of the condition mandating that all servers and sellers attend the Sheriff's servers training class. Additional comments were solicited but none were given. Member

Williamson moved to approve a Dining Room with Beer and Wine Liquor License for Evangelina Velasco, doing business as Taqueria La Guadalupana, located at 2495 North Carson Street, Carson City, including a nonrefundable investigation fee of \$500, an original new application fee of \$500, and the Liquor License per Quarter Fee of \$150; and, additionally, all sellers or servers of liquor must attend the Sheriff's Office Servers Education Class within three months of the business opening. Member Aldean seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

B. ACTION TO CONTINUE A SCHEDULED LIQUOR BOARD SHOW CAUSE HEARING DATE OF APRIL 3, 2008 ,TO THE APRIL 17, 2008, MEETING AT THE REQUEST OF THE APPLICANT'S ATTORNEY, RICHARD A. MOLEZZO, ESQ., REPRESENTING KIL YE (KATIE) CHEW FOR KATIE'S BAR, REGARDING LIQUOR LICENSE NO. 08-00023400 (8:38:54)
- Ms. Chew's attorney, Richard A. Molezzo, had submitted a written request for a continuance. (A copy is in the file.) Mr. Molezzo has been retained by Ms. Chew as her legal counsel. He is scheduled to be in Federal Court on other matters on April 3. His letter assured Senior Deputy District Attorney Joel Benton that he will be present for a hearing on April 17 if the meeting is continued to that date. Member Furlong indicated that the Sheriff's Office did not object to the continuance. Additional comments were solicited but none were given. Member Aldean moved the scheduled show cause hearing of April 3, 2008, to April 17, 2008, Liquor Board meeting agenda at the request of Richard A. Molezzo, Esquire, representing Kil Ye "Katie" Chew for Katie's Bar regarding Liquor License No. 08-00023400. Member Livermore seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.

There being no other matters for consideration, Chairperson Teixeira adjourned the Liquor and Entertainment Board.
