# F. CONSENT AGENDA

All matters listed under the consent agenda are considered routine and may be acted upon by the Regional Transportation Commission with one action and without an extensive hearing. Any member of the Commission or any citizen may request that an item be taken from the consent agenda, discussed and acted upon separately during this meeting. The Chair, or the Vice Chair, retains discretion in deciding whether or not an item will be pulled off the consent agenda.

F-1 Agreement with Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) to provide to CAMPO the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) 5303 funds for Federal Fiscal Years 2008-2010.

**Staff Summary:** The FTA 5303 funds are used for planning Metropolitan and Statewide mass transportation activities. CAMPO uses these funds for activities such as updating the Regional Transportation Plan, Public Participation, development of Short-Range Transit Plan, and regional transit coordination.

**F-2** Agreement with Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) to provide to CAMPO non-federal state funds to use as local match towards capital purchases.

**Staff Summary:** NDOT state funds will be used as local match towards capital purchases using Federal Transit Administration 5307 and 5309 funds. The funds will be available for use October 1, 2008 and good through September 30, 2010.

# G. PUBLIC MEETING ITEMS:

**G-1** Presentation by the Nevada Department of Transportation regarding the Department's draft 2008-2028 Statewide Long Range Transportation Plan.

**Staff Summary:** The Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) has developed a "Draft" 2008-2028 Statewide Long Range Transportation Plan that addresses Nevada's non-metropolitan transportation needs. This is a policy planning document – no construction projects are identified. All state DOT's are required to produce a long-range statewide transportation plan with a minimum 20-year forecast that provides for the development and implementation of the multimodal transportation system for the State. The Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users requires that the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) process is carried out in coordination with the statewide transportation planning process and the State is required to develop its Plan in cooperation with the MPO. The 2030 CAMPO Regional Transportation Plan is incorporated into this Plan by reference.

**G-2** Policy on the distribution of Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) state funds.

**Staff Summary:** NDOT state funds will be used as local match towards capital purchases using Federal Transit Administration 5307 and 5309 funds. Funds will be distributed to member agencies based on population and eligible expenses.

**G-3** Approval of the CAMPO 2030 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP).

**Staff Summary:** CAMPO has concluded a 30-day public comment period for the 2030 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP), and is seeking Board approval of the document. Pending Board approval, the 2030 RTP will be forwarded on to the Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) and the US DOT (Federal Highway Administration and Federal Transit Administration) for approval.

**G-4** Approval of the CAMPO FFY 2009 – FFY 2012 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).

**Staff Summary:** CAMPO has concluded a 30-day public comment period for the FFY 2009 – FFY 2012 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), and is seeking Board approval of the document. Pending Board approval, TIP will be forwarded on to the Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) and the US DOT (Federal Highway Administration and Federal Transit Administration) for approval.

**G-5** Presentation on NDOT's Transportation Enhancements Program.

**Staff Summary:** NDOT is in the process of soliciting applications for the Transportation Enhancements Program. Transportation enhancements are transportation-related activities designed to strengthen the cultural, aesthetic, and environmental aspects of the nation's intermodal transportation system. Eligible projects include provisions for bicycle and pedestrian facilities, acquisition of scenic easements or historic sites, scenic beautification, environmental mitigation, and preservation/rehabilitation of transportation structures to name a few. Any local or State government agency or tribal organization wishing to apply for eligible projects within CAMPO boundaries must do so through CAMPO, and projects such as bicycle and pedestrian enhancements must be consistent with the CAMPO 2030 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP).
