**Subject Title:** For Possible Action: To introduce, on first reading, Bill No.\_\_\_\_, AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CARSON CITY MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 10-VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, SECTION 10 SPECIAL RESPONSIBILITIES OF VEHICLE DRIVERS AND OWNERS, SECTION-10.25.060 DRIVING WHILE LICENSE CANCELED, SUSPENDED OR REVOKED-SUSPENDED SENTENCES AND PLEA BARGAINING PROHIBITED-PENALTIES BY UPDATING THE NEVADA REVISED STATUTES WHICH PERTAIN TO DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL OR A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE IN THE SECTION TO REFLECT THE CHANGES MADE BY THE LEGISLATURE'S REPLACING AND RESTRUCTURING OF NRS CHAPTER 484-TRAFFIC LAWS; AND BY ADDING THE EXPRESS LANGUAGE THAT THE MANDATORY PUNISHMENTS LISTED DO NOT APPLY WHEN THE REVOCATION PERIOD HAS EXPIRED; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO.

**Staff Summary:** Currently, Title 10, Chapter 25 Section 10.25.060 driving while license canceled, suspended or revoked- suspended sentences and plea bargaining prohibited-penalties, cites to provisions of Chapter 484 of the NRS which have been re-numbered. This ordinance updates the NRS sections cited in the CCMC. As the sections of the NRS the CCMC currently cites have been replaced with new sections, the CCMC should reflect such changes.
