Subject Title: Action to approve a lot line adjustment transferring City property adjacent to Empire Elementary School to the Carson City School District. (Roger Moellendorf, Parks and Recreation Director)

Staff Summary: This item was brought to the Board of Supervisors during the April 7, 2011, Board meeting. The Board approved the conceptual plan to transfer through a lot line adjustment City owned property containing a playground immediately adjacent to Empire School and a minor portion of Park Terrace Park to be developed as a small parking lot for use by the school and the park. The Board also directed staff to forward the plan to the Parks and Recreation Commission for their recommendation. The plan was brought to the Commission on April 19, 2011, and was approved without conditions.

Recommended Board Action: I move to approve a lot line adjustment transferring City property adjacent to Empire Elementary School to the Carson City School District.

Explanation for Recommended Board Action: In 1990, through a lot line adjustment, the Carson City School District conveyed property located immediately adjacent to the west side of Empire Elementary School to the City for the purpose of building a public playground on the property. A joint use agreement was entered into by the District and the City addressing the maintenance and the use of the playground. Essentially the agreement stipulated that the City would construct the playground, that the District was responsible for the maintenance of the equipment, and that the District would use the equipment during school hours and the City would have use of the playground during non-school hours. With the recent passage of the new school bond, the District desires to replace the portable classroom buildings on this property with permanent buildings. In addition, the District desires to construct 18 parking spaces and other minor improvements on Park Terrace Park. This requires a transfer of a small portion of City property to the District through a lot line adjustment. A new agreement will be crafted to address the joint use of these improvements.
