<u>AUTHORITY:</u> NRS 501.260 and 501.270 provide for a board of up to five members who are residents of Carson City. NRS 501.265 outlines qualified members as residents of the county who are sportsmen or engaged in ranching or farming in the county. NRS 501.275 outlines the term limit to 3-year terms (reappointment OK).

<u>MEETINGS:</u> Meetings vary in number, usually with the onset of gaming and fishing seasons and/or upon the call of the Chairman, and are generally scheduled concurrent with the Board of Wildlife Commissioners' annual meeting schedule.

<u>PURPOSE:</u> To assist and advise the Nevada Department of Wildlife and the Wildlife Commission on matters pertaining to wildlife and fish.

#### COUNTY ADVISORY BOARD TO MANAGE WILDLIFE

## NRS 501.260 Creation; number of members; officers.

- 1. There is hereby created a county advisory board to manage wildlife in each of the several counties.
  - 2. In a county whose population:
- (a) Is less than 400,000, each board consists of three or five members, at the discretion of the board of county commissioners.
- (b) Is 400,000 or more, each board consists of five or seven members, at the discretion of the board of county commissioners.
  - 3. A chairman and vice chairman must be selected by each board.

## NRS 501.265 Appointment of members; vacancies.

- 1. The board of county commissioners shall appoint qualified persons to the board who are residents of the county and are:
  - (a) Sportsmen; or
  - (b) Engaged in ranching or farming in the county.
- 2. Within 60 days after a vacancy occurs, the board of county commissioners shall appoint a member to the board upon the recommendation of the organized sportsmen and residents of the county.
- 3. Within 90 days after a vacancy occurs, the board of county commissioners shall report to the Commission the name and address of each member appointed.

NRS 501.270 Qualifications of members. The members of the board must be citizens of Nevada and bona fide residents of the county from which appointed.

## NRS 501.275 Appointment and terms of members.

- 1. The boards of county commissioners shall appoint members to the boards of their respective counties.
  - 2. Each member appointed shall serve a term of 3 years.

NRS 501.285 Compensation of members. Members of the board shall serve without salary or compensation.

NRS 501.290 Meetings. The board shall meet before those meetings of the Commission at which seasons, bag limits or hours are to be established and at such other times as the chairman may call or the Commission may request.
