This is an update for the City Supervisors on utilization of the \$27,500 grant from the City for Adolescent Programming at Carson Tahoe Regional Healthcare. Through September 30, 2006, \$19,240 of this amount has been spent on a variety of tasks associated with the adolescent treatment services. See below for specific amounts:
