Subject: Update on Redevelopment Allocation Plan

RECOMMENDED RACC MOTION: No action.

DISCUSSION:

At the request of RACC members, this is a discussion item regarding an update on the Redevelopment Allocation Plan and possible future expenditures. The RACC annually discusses the Allocation Plan during its November meeting and makes recommendations to the Redevelopment Authority at its February meeting. This item is an opportunity for the RACC to get an update on planned expenditures and discuss ideas for future expenditures.

Attached is the 2017 Redevelopment Allocation Plan approved by the Redevelopment Authority on March 16, 2017. The Plan provides for Redevelopment expenditures from a portion of the Redevelopment Revolving Fund for the next five years, allowing funds to be reserved as necessary to carry out the identified projects and programs. Each column in the spreadsheet represents a Fiscal Year, and at the bottom of each column the projected remaining Undesignated funds are shown as well as the Ending Fund Balance that is carried forward to the following year budget.

Fiscal Year 2017 (last year)

All the funds identified in for FY 2017 have been allocated except for approximately \$41,000 in the Façade Improvement Program line item, as noted on a prior agenda item. The \$41,000 plus any additional unused portion of those funds will be carried forward into the FY 2018 Undesignated account for use on other Redevelopment projects or programs.

Fiscal Year 2018 (current budget)

A total of \$480,000 has been allocated in FY 2018 to various project and programs, with \$57,176 currently undesignated and available for expenditures. The Undesignated account is expected to be augmented with the remaining Façade Improvement Program funds in August, resulting in available Undesignated funds of over \$98,000 in the current budget.

The \$200,000 for East/West Downtown Street Improvements and \$50,000 for Telegraph to Spear Alley Improvements will be used to tie those improvements in with the planned downtown Curry Street improvements, which are scheduled for construction in 2018. Other funds have been allocated or will be allocated upon request (e.g. the Utility Extension Assistance program), depending on the particular project or program.

It should also be noted that the RACC recommended and the Redevelopment Authority approved funding for a part-time code enforcement officer to assist with code enforcement in the Redevelopment District. That position has been funded for FY 2018 and beyond and the position is expected to be filled within the next month.

The RACC may discuss other possible projects or programs for funding with the current Undesignated funds, including activities that may be planned for this year or future years. The RACC will have a comprehensive discussion at its November 6 meeting to discuss possible projects and programs for the long-term Allocation Plan, with final recommendations for the Redevelopment Authority scheduled for the RACC's action in February 2018.
